An indenture of feoffment between Samuel Totten of the one part and George Branch of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Richard Telle Benjamin Warren & Edward Fisher the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

Upon the petition of Benjamin Turner and William Turner execs of Simon Turner dec'd against John Butch for four pounds and interest from the 13 day of October 1763 by note This day came the plaintiffs and the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the Motion of the said plaintiffs It is considered by the court that they recover against the said defendant the said four pounds and interest and their costs by them in this behalf expended

This day came as well the attorney for our lord the King as the said Henry who saith that he is guilty of the trespass assault & battery in the indictment mentioned and submits himself to the judgment of court whereupon It is considered by the court that the said Henry Thomas forfeit and pay to our said sovereign lord the King the sum of five pounds and that he also pay the costs of this indictment

Upon the petition of John Wilkinson against John Bird junr for two pounds three shillings and six pence This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover
