

Upon the petition of Lazarus Whithead against Joseph Cobb for four hundred and thirty pounds of real tobacco and fifteen shillings or one hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco due by judgment This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said four hundred and thirty pounds of real tobacco and fifteen shillings and his costs by him in this behalf expended

On the Motion of Henry Taylor and Thomas Ridley witnesses for Joseph Cobb at the suit of Lazarus Whithead It is Ordered that the said Joseph pay them respectively twenty five pounds of real tobacco for one day's attendance each of them on this court according to law

It appearing to the court that Henry Thomas is a person of bad behaviour It is Ordered that he find security for his good behaviour for six months whereupon the said Thomas together Ambrose Grogan and his security acknowledged themselves indebted to our lord the King in twenty pounds each conditioned that the said Henry Thomas be of good behaviour for the space of six months then this recognizance to be void and It is Ordered that he pay the costs of this recognizance

Ordered that Benjamin Simmons James Jones Henry Taylor John Simmons Benjamin Jacrell and Charles Bachman ^{at the three courts} or any four of them do run Ford Bridge and report to the court the state and circumstances thereof

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court in course
