

Upon the petition of Lazarus Whitehead against Joseph Cobb for four hundred and thirty pounds of ree Tobaco and fifteen shillings or one hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco due by judgment This day came the parties by their attorneys costs being fully heard It is Considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said four hundred and thirty pounds of ree Tobaco and fifteen shillings and his costs by him in his behalf expended

On the Motion of Henry Taylor and Thomas Ridley witness for Joseph Cobb at the suit of Lazarus Whitehead It is Ordred that the said Joseph pay them respectively twenty five pounds of ree Tobaco for one days attendance each of them on this court according to law

It appearing to the court that Henry Thomas is a son of bad behaviour It is Ordred that he find security for his good behaviour for six months whereupon the said Henry Thomas together Ambrose Grozard his security acknowledged themselves indebted to our lord the King in twenty pounds each conditioned that the said Henry Thomas be of good behaviour for the space of six months then this recognizance to be void and It is Ordred that he pay the costs of this recognizance

Ordred that Benjamin Simmons James Jones Henry Taylor John Simmons Benjamin James and Charles Barham or any four of them do ride Tolls bridge and uproot to the west the state and circumstances thereof

Ordred that the court be adjourned till the court in session
