Upon the petition of Thomas Putton against Abshalom Williamson for two pounds eighteen shillings and eleven pence due by account This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard It is considered by the court that the petition be dismissed and that the plaintiff pay unto the defendant his costs

Upon the petition of Nathan Bryant against Henry Barber for one pound fourteen shillings due by note of hand This day came the plaintiff by Edward Tipton his attorney and the defendant having been duly summoned & served with a copy of the petition not appearing On the Motion of the plaintiff It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said one pound fourteen shillings & his costs by him in this behalf expended

Upon the petition of Simon Harris against John Lankford for one pound nine shillings and six pence and interest due by hand This day came the plaintiff and the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and account and not appearing On the Motion of the plaintiff It is considered by the court that he recover against the said defendant the said one pound nine shillings & six pence together with interest for the same from the 1st day of July 1767 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

The last will and testament of Thomas Obery died was presented in court by John Obery the executor therein named proved by the solemn affirmation of James Jordan Scott and Jordan Benson of the people called Quakers two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be sworn And on the Motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said John Obery together with James Jordan Scott his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of £200 for the said John's due faithful administration on the said decedent's estate & performance of his will
