

At a Court held for the county of Southampton on Thursday
the 13th day of October 1768

Acoid of gift from John Love to Leobiller Love was acknow-
ledged by the said John and ordered to be recorded

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On a complaint against Moses Bennett for a maim
and breach of the peace on the body of Phillip Bennett his
child who is yet in great danger It is Ordered that the
said Moses Bennett be committed to the goal of this
county till further proceedings be had against him -
concerning the premises

An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Barnes & Martha
his wife of the one part and Benjamin Whitfield of the
other part was acknowledged by the said Thomas & Martha
the being first privately examined as the law directs and
ordered to be recorded

Ordered that Elias Heering Edmund Tyler Sampson
Pitman and John Council or any three of them do examine
state and settle Robert Johnsons account of his administration
of Sampson Johnsons estate due and make report
Hereof to the court

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of
James Sampson deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded
Sampson Newson having obtained an attachment against the estate of
Newit Waps who hath privately removed himself or co-absent
that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him
for two pounds nineteen shillings and four pence due to the
said Sampson Henry Taylor gent. Sheriff of this county now
made return that he had executed the said attachment in
the hands of Arthur Long and that he had summoned her
as a garnisher This day came the said Sampson Newson
and Elizabeth Long and Dany Long execs of the said Arthur
Long appeared and being first sworn depose that the
testator had in his hands at the time of executing this
attachment the sum of three hundred pounds of tobacco of the
estate of the said Newit which they have deposited in the
hands of the Sheriff for the use of the said Sampson Newson
