Ordered that Thomas Day guardian of the orphans of Elias Foster do make up his accounts of his guardianship of the said orphans estates and return them to the next court

An indenture of feoffment between Edmund Tyler of the one part and William Doyle of the other part and the memorandum of livery of seisen thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Edmund and ordered to be recorded and Sarah the wife of the said Edmund Tyler personally appeared in court and being first privately examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture

An indenture of feoffment between Edmund Tyler of the one part and Moses Heasty of the other part and a memorandum of receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Edmund Tyler and ordered to be recorded and Sarah the wife of the said Edmund Tyler personally appeared in court and being first privately examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture

An indenture of feoffment between James Harris & Mary his wife of the one part and Corneilus Morris of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Chaumon Harris and John Harris two of the witnesses thereto

The last will and testament of James Heasty deceased was presented in court by James Heasty one of the executors therein named proved by the oaths of John Vaper and Rachell Vaper two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said James together with Samuel Hlade his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £200 for the said James due and faithful administration of the said decedents estate and performance of his will

Ordered that John Gardner Francis Rose Joshua Grove & Benjamin Bradshaw or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any personal estate of James Heasty deceased and return the appraisement to the court
