

William Visk Benjamin Tyus and Burnell Williamson
acknowledged themselves indebted to our lord the King each in
the sum of fifty pounds of their respective Lands & Tenements
goods and chattels to be levied Yet upon this condition that if
they shall severally & respectively make their personal appear-
ance at the next general court to be held in Williamsburg
on the sixth day thereof and give testimony on behalf of our
lord the King agst William Jones otherwise Chapman for felony
then this recognizance to be void

of December 1768

An indenture of feoffment between Daniel Barrow & Martha
his wife of the one part and George Gurley jun of the other part
was proved by the oath of John Barrow and having been further
proved by two other witnesses was ordered to be recorded

An indenture of feoffment between Anthony Covany
of the one part and Richard Wynn of the other part and
a memorandum of livery of seisen thereon endorsed were acknowledged
by the said Anthony and ordered to be recorded and Mary the wife
of the said Anthony personally appeared in court & being first-
privily examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished
her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture

Mary Simmons is by the court appointed guardian to
Heason William Edwin and Jane Simmonses orphans of Charles
Simmons decd whereupon the said Mary together with John
Simmons her security entered into and acknowledged their bond
in the penalty of £2000 for the said Mary's due & faithful
guardianship of the said orphans estate & indemnifying the
court

An indenture of Mortgage between Nathan Wallman of
the one part and William Wallman of the other part was proved by
the oath of Burnell Williamson and by the solemn affirmation of Benjⁿ
Bailey jun and Amos Bailey jun witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded

A deed Poll between Asaph Williamson & William Williamson
of the one part and Thomas Harris of the other part was proved by
the oath of John Clarke the same having been further acknow-
ledged by Asaph & proved as William by two other witnesses & ordered
to be recorded
