Upon the petition of Mary Andrews widow of Robert Andrews deceased against Ambrose Williams and William Brownman for three pounds six shillings and three pence half penny by bill This day came as well the plaintiff by Edward Fisher her attorney as the defendants in their proper person who confess the allegation of the said petition to be true Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendants the said three pounds six shillings and three pence half penny and her costs by her in this behalf expended But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of one pound thirteen shillings and one penny half and interest from the 17th day of November 1766 to the time of payment

This day came as well the plaintiff by Edward Fisher her attorney as the defendants in their proper person who confess the plaintiff's action for six pounds nineteen shillings eight pence the debt in the declaration mentioned Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendants the said six pounds nineteen shillings and eight pence and her costs by her about her suit in this behalf expended and the said defendants in mercy But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of thirteen shillings and six pence and interest from the 17 day of July 1767 to the time of payment

The petition of William Andrews agt John Nicby is dismissed for want of prosecution

The presentment of the Grand Jury agt Benjamin Tucker is dismissed

Our Lord the King

This day came as well the attorney for our Lord the King as the said Benjamin Clements who saith he is guilty in manner and form as the presentment agt him hath alleged whereupon It is considered by the court that he be fined six pence and that he also pay the costs of this prosecution

The presentments of the grand jury agt William Ellis & Thomas Gilliam are dismissed

Ordered that Peteron Thrope one of the executors named in the will of Timothy Thrope deceased be summoned to appear at the next court & declare whether he will qualify himself as such
