upon the petition of Lemuel Kiddick against Mary Eppes for three pounds due by account This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and account and not appearing On the motion of the plaintiff It is considered by the court that he recover agst the said defendant the said three pounds and his costs by him in this behalf expended

Richard Wells came into court and undertook for the defendants that in case they should be cast in this suit they shall pay the condemnation of the court or under their bonds to prison in discharge of the same or that he the said Richard Wells would do it for them whereupon came as well the plaintiff by Edward Fisher his attorney as the defendants in their proper persons who confessed the plaintiffs action for thirteen pounds the debt in the declaration mentioned Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendants the said thirteen pounds and his costs by him about this suit in this behalf expended and the said defendants in money &c But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of six pounds ten shillings together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the fifth day of May 1768 to the time of payment And that the plaintiff agree to stay execution of this judgment three months
