On the Motion of Joseph Pope and John Fly witnesses for John Jackson at the suit of Patience Jackson It is Ordered that the said John pay them ^{respectively} one hundred and fifty pounds of neat tobacco for six days attendance each of them on this court

On the Motion of Samuel Slade and John Gardner witnesses for Joshua Grove against David Denfon It is Ordered that the said Joshua pay them respectively three hundred and seventy five pounds of neat tobacco for fifteen days attendance each of them on this court according to law

On the Motion of Benjamin Denfon a witness for Joshua Grove agt David Denfon It is Ordered that the said Joshua pay him three hundred and twenty five pounds of neat tobacco for thirteen days attendance on this court according to law

On the Motion of Richard Drake a witness for David Denfon at the suit of Joshua Grove It is Ordered that the said David pay him three hundred and fifty pounds of neat tobacco for fourteen days attendance on this court according to law
