But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of seven pounds and nine pence together with interest for the same from the seventh day of September 1768 to the time of payment.

An indenture of feoffment between Arthur Anington of the one part and John Adams of the other part and the memorandum of living of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Arthur and ordered to be recorded.

This day came as well the plaintiff by Edward Fisher their attorney as the defendant in person who confessed the plaintiff's action for two hundred and twenty five pounds current money of South Carolina the debt in the declaration mentioned *Therefore* It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said two hundred and twenty five pounds and their costs by them about their suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in money. But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of thirty two pounds current money of Virginia together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 28th day of October 1762 to the time of payment. And that the plaintiff agree to stay execution of this judgment six months.

Aupok of the division of the Lands of John Little agreeable to his last will was returned and on the Motion of Simon Turner ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Moses Pearty of the one part and Francis Rose of the other part and the memorandum of living of seisin thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Thomas Chapple Matthew Meadum and John Wood witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Samuel Westbrooke of the one part and Samuel Westbrooke of the other part and the memorandum of living of seisin and wife thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Samuel and ordered to be recorded.
