In Chancery

It is the opinion of the Court that the persons already appointed have full power & that therefore the motion does not properly come before them until the report of the said persons is returned to this Court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Charles Simons decd was returned & ordered to be recorded.

An Indenture of Trustment between Samuel Smith of the one part & Thomas Chappell of the other part & a memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Samuel Smith & ordered to be recorded & Mary the wife of the said Smith personally appeared in court & being first privately examined as the law direct voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture.

An Indenture of bargain & sale between Thomas ^{Day} Chappell of the one part & Thomas Chappell of the other part was acknowledged by the said ^{Day} & ordered to be recorded & Elizabeth the wife of the said Day personally appeared in court & being first privately examined as the law direct voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture.

On the petition of William Glover he is allowed to keep ordinary near his house in this county for one Year from this time giving security.
