It is considered by the Court that the said plaintiff recover against the defendant the said two pounds six shillings & his costs by him in this behalf expended.

James Booth is by the Court appointed a constable of this County in the room of Anselm Jones who is discharged from that office & the J. Booth was sworn in accordingly.

The petition Henry Soper against Benjamin Denpen is continued at the plaintiff's costs.

On the petition of James Jordan Scott for leave to erect a water mill on Notonway swamp he having lands on both sides the said swamp it is ordered that the sheriff summon a jury of twelve freeholders of the vicinage who being first duly sworn before a justice of the peace or the said sheriff shall diligently view & examine the lands that may be affected or laid under water by reason of building such mill together with the timber & other conveniences thereon that they report under their hands & seals the true value of the damages to the party holding such lands or to any other person or persons.

William Andrews is by the Court appointed surveyor of the highway from Garigs Bridge to the Supra line & it is ordered that the hands that formerly worked that part kept by Walter Cary be added to this precinct & that he keep the same in repair according to Law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in Court.
