Orders that Robert William Robert Williamson Esq. Brit. & Chas. Nering or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any & personal estate of Arthur Currell decd & return the appraisement to Court

A commission from his excellency the Governor to James Jones gent. to be sheriff of this County during pleasure was produced in court by the said James Jones & read & thereupon he together with Howell Edmunds Jeph. Browne Abudagon Jones & Richard Kellogg his securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds payable & conditioned as in the said condition is directed & then the said Jones having first taken the oaths appointed by act of parliament to be taken instead of the oaths of allegiance & supremacy & taken & subscribed the abjuration oath & subscribed the test was sworn sheriff of this County
