Ordered that Edmund Tyler Samson Thomas Vherst Corby or any two of them do examine state & settle an account current of the estate of Edmund Doyel & make report thereof to the court

Ordered that Nicholas Waget Rich^d. Rich^d James Jordan Scott and Abriagton Jones or any two of them do let the rebuilding of Cypress bridge & make report thereof to the Court

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the Court in Course
