The indenture of settlement between John Powell & Esther his wife of the one part & Joseph Powell of the other part together with a receipt thereon intended were acknowledged by the aforesaid John Powell & Esther his wife she being first privately examined as the Law directs & ordered to be recorded Sarah <sup>orphan of Arthur Long</sup> Long this day came into Court & chose Joseph Phillips for his guardian who together William Simmons his security entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the said Joseph securing the said orphan's estate & indemnifying the Court.

Davis Long orphan of Arthur Long came into Court & chose Thos. Davis for his guardian who with Henry Davis his security entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for securing the said orphan's estate & indemnifying the Court.

Henry Davis is by the Court appointed guardian to Arthur Long infant orphan of Arthur Long who with Thomas Davis his security entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the said Henry securing the said orphan's estate & indemnifying the Court.

Ordered that the Churchwardens of St. Luke bind out James Harrison & Robert Harrison poor children of Ann Harrison according to Law.

Articles of agreement entered into by Albiadon Jones of the one part & Mary Simmons of the other part were proved by the oaths of Benjamin Simmons Francis Newsum & Jacob Johnson the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded.

The last will & testament of John Thomas was presented in court by John Thomas Blom the testator therein named & proved by the oaths of Jeremiah Ellis Joseph Newsum & Robert Williams three of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded And on the motion of John Thomas Blom who made oath according to Law certificate was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security to him upon the said last together with George Gurly & Charles Briggs entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three thousand pounds for the said John Thomas Blom and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent & performance of his will.

Ordered that Micah Edwards Will<sup>m</sup> Thomas Thomas Moor & Henry Thomas or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves
