 the plaintiff twenty shillings current money & all legal
 costs in prosecuting the within suit certified under our
 hands this 8th day of March 1770. Henry Taylor
 John Taylor.

Whereupon it is considered that the plaintiff recover against
 the defendant the said sum of twenty shillings & his costs
 by him about his suit in this behalf expended

Ordered that the sheriff summon twenty four of the most capa-
 ble persons in this county to appear on the second Thursday
 in May next before a grand jury of inquest on the body
 of this County

Ordered that the churchwardens of Lubbock out John

On the motion of Mary Cathon one of the People called
 quakers who made affirmation according to Law & certificate
 was granted her for obtaining letters of administration on
 the estate of John Cathon and giving security whereupon
 the said Mary together with Jas Jordan Scott & Nicholas
 Mayet her securities entered into & acknowledged their
 bond in the penalty of five hundred Pounds for the said
 Mary due & faithful administration on the estate of the
 said decedent

Ordered that John Drake Joseph Cobb Thomas Greenchaw
 Jesse Drake or any three of them being first sworn before a
 justice of the Peace do appraise in current money the slaves
 if any & personal estate of J^{rs} Cathon and return the
 appraisement to Court
