An Indenture of feoffment between John Taylor of the one part & Anthony Evans of the other part together with a memorandum of livery of seizen thereon entered were acknowledged by the said John Taylor & ordered to be recorded

Upon the petition of James Bridger against James Evans for two pounds five shillings & ten pence due by account This day came the pth by his attorney & the dependant having been duly summoned & served with a copy of the petition & not appearing on the motion of the pth pth it is considered by the court that he recover against the pth dependant the sum of £2. 5. 10. & his costs by him in this behalf expended

Upon the petition of James Bridger against George Lawrence for two pounds eleven shillings & two pence half penny due by account This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the dependant having been duly summoned & served with a copy of the petition & not appearing ^{on the motion of the pth} it is considered that he recover against the said dependant the said sum of £2. 11. 2½ & his costs by him in this behalf expended
