

the following effects (to wit) 7 head of Cattle 1 mare a parcel of saddles 3 grindstones 3 Cows & lambs 1 Iron Pott & hooks 2 beds of furniture 3 Churn 1 Box 1 Tub 1 Pale 1 saddle 3 Pewter basins 1 Linen wheel 1 wollen & 2 trays 1 frying pan 1 Iron kettle 1 Box Iron & heaters 3 P. Cotton cards 1 Tin funnel 1 jug 1 Coffee Pott & 1 son and 1 pig. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the defendant not now appearing to answer the said effects & the plaintiff having proved his account. It is considered by the court that he recover against the said Simon Woodard the sum of eighteen pounds eight shilling & seven pence & his costs by him in this behalf expended Benjamin Williams a garnisher appeared & being first sworn deposed that he hath in his hands the following effects to wit 11 head of sheep a mare 30th Bacon 3 Cows hides 19 Cyder casks 1 hog's head 14 fowls 22 Pigs a parcel of trap hoops a Coltr. a Rope 9 Green 1 Cart saddle 2 Collars & harness 2 Weagers of the said Woodards estate. Whereupon it is considered by the court that the said Benjamin Williams deliver the ^{sd} goods to the sheriff of this County & that the sheriff sell the same at public auction for ready money & therewith discharge the aforesaid debt (reserving so much thereof as will discharge John Ferguson attachment obtained before a justice of the peace against the said Woodard) or so much thereof as the sale shall amount (after the former reservation) & the costs of this suit & that he also return an account of his proceedings to this Court

An Indenture of settlement between Jesse Jones of the one part & Burtain Jones of the other part was proved by the oath of Henry Crafford Horace Hoyle & Joseph Smith three of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded

An inventory & appraisement of the estate of Nathan Pope was this day returned & ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of settlement between William Davis alias Stewart of the one part & James Bullard together with a memorandum of livery of seisin & receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oath of Nathaniel Wainwright & having been before proved by two other witnesses was ordered to be recorded
