This day came the parties by their attornies & thereupon came also a jury to wit Jacob Johnson Moses Foster Thomas Clifton William Willard Lewis Nervens William Foster Howell Harris Morgan Daewry Benjamin Spivey Sam. Pullen Francis Rose & Nathaniel Tatum who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon their oaths do say that the defendant is guilty in manner & form as the plaintiff against him hath complained & they do assess the Plaintiff damages by occasion thereof to one Pound ten shillings therefore it is considered by the court that Plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said sum of one Pound ten shillings & the said defendant in mercy &c.

On the motion of Elisha Darden a witness for Samuel Browne against Benjamin Williams it is ordered that the said Samuel pay him six hundred & ^{thirty} three Pounds of tobacco for seven days attendance on the Court and travelling fourteen miles nine times returning according to Law
