William Hay gent. produced a license from the examiners appointed by law to practice as an attorney in the county & other inferior courts of this colony & having taken the usual oath to his majesty, person & government & taken & subscribed the abjuration oath & is sworn an attorney of this court

An Indenture of Shipment between Samson Pitman of the one part & Richard Kelle of the other part together with a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the above named Samson Pitman & ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the churchwardens of the Parish of Netherway bind out Martha Abraham a poor child according to Law

An Indenture of Shipment between John Blyth of the one part & Lewis Jones of the other part together with a memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said John Blyth the party thereto & ordered to be recorded

The attachment being returned executed on one pewter spoon This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the defendant not now appearing to reply the said attached effects It is considered by the court that judgment be entered for the pth against the said defendant for what damages the said pth hath sustained to be ascertained upon an enquiry by a jury

Samuel Jenken d^{ft} In Debt

The defendant not now appearing on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney it is ordered that an attachment issue against the estate of the said defendant for thirty pounds & be returnable to the next Court

This day came the pth by their attorney & the defendant being arraigned & not appearing on the motion the pth pth it is considered by the court that judgment be entered for the pth against the said defendant & William Turner who is returned security for his appearance unless the said defendant shall appear & plead at the next Court
