 to Court

An Indenture ofIndentment between Thomas Carny & Elizabeth his
 wife of the one part & John Luter of the other part together with
 a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Thomas
 Carny & Elizabeth his wife who being first privately examined
 as the law directs & ordered to be recorded
