

The last will and testament of Robert Hart was presented in Court by Jesse Hart the executor therein named & proved by the oaths of John Hart & Richard Andrews the witnesses thereto & orders to be recorded And on the motion of the said execr who made oath according to Law certificate was granted him for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said execr together with Joseph Hart his security entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the said execr due & faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent & performance of his will

Ordered that Jesse Womble Aaron Phillips Nathaniel Holliman & Samuel Williamson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the Peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any & personal estate of Robt Hart decd & return the appraisement to Court

The last will and testament of Micajah Edwards was presented in court by Benjamin Blunt & John Thomas Blount two of the execs therein named liberty being reserved for the other to join in the probate thereof & proved by the oaths of Henry Thomas Benjamin Evans & William Edwards the witnesses thereto and orders to be recorded and on the motion of the said execs who made oath according to Law Certificate was granted them for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said execs together with John Blunt John Powell Tho^s Blunt Joshua Welchson their securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand pounds for the said execs due & faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent & performance of his will

Ordered that Henry Thomas William Thomas William Willson & Thomas Moore or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the Peace do appraise in current money the slaves & personal estate of Micajah Edwards decd & return the appraisement to Court

An Indenture of Coverture between Benjamin Stephen of the one part & Thomas Pullen of the other part together with a memorandum of living of seison thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Jesse Gray Armistead & William Why the solemn affirmation of Thomas Pullen one of the parties called question three of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded
