On a bond given to upholding the estate of
the S. Morgan Drury taken by virtue
of an execution issuing on a judgment
obtained in this Court by the plaintiff
against the S. defendant

On the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney & by virtue of
the act of assembly in that case made and provided the S.
defendant having had legal notice thereof execution is awarded
the plaintiff against the said defendant for three pounds nine
shillings & seven pence half penny together with lawful interest
from the 25th day of May 1770 to be computed after the rate of
five per Centum per Annum till paid according to the conditions
of the bond aforesaid & for his costs by him in this behalf
expended

On the motion of Abraham Mitchell a witness for Kinchen Taylor
at the suit of Thomas Fisher it is ordered that the S. Taylor
pay him one hundred & fifty pounds of tobacco for six
days attendance on this Court according to Law

On the motion of James Lucas a witness for Kinchen Taylor
at the suit of William Clarke it is ordered that the S.
Taylor pay him one hundred & twenty five pounds of
net tobacco for five days attendance on this Court
according to Law

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Thos. Stephenson
and was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Council Johnson of the one
part and Ann Drake of the other part together with a
memorandum of livery of seisin and receipt thereon endorsed
were acknowledged by the said Mary Johnson & ordered to be
recorded

Upon the complaint of John Barnes an apprentice against
William Mackie his master it is the opinion of the Court
upon hearing of the parties that the said complaint be dismissed
