who confessed the allegation of the petition to be true
therefore it is considered by the court that he recover
the ^d. sum of five pounds according to the act of assembly
in that case made & provided & his costs by him in this
behalf expended

Upon the petition of Joshua Maisty against Lerby Potts for
two pounds due by note This day came the plaintiff by his
attorney & the dependant having been duly summoned & served
with a copy of the said petition & not appearing on the motion
of the said plaintiff it is considered by the court that the plaintiff
recover against the said dependant the said sum of two pounds
& his costs by him in this behalf expended
