 eighteen miles ten times & returning according to law

 William Agar & against Benjamin Clifton it is ordered  
 that the said Agar pay them one hundred & seventy five pounds  
 of next tobacco for seven days attendance on this court  
 according to law

On the motion of Joel Vasser a witness for John Adams at the  
 suit of John Kirby it is ordered that the said Adams  
 pay him two hundred and twenty five pounds of next  
 tobacco for nine days attendance on this court according  
 to law

On the motion of Mosie McKenny a witness for James Barnes  
 against William Glau it is ordered that the said  
 Barnes pay him one hundred pounds of next tobacco  
 for four days attendance on this court according to law
