Upon the petition of James Bridger against Moses Johnson for two pounds nineteen shillings & eleven pence. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the defendant having been duly summoned & served with a copy of the petition & account & not appearing thereon the motion of the pl^t who proved his account to be just it is considered by the Court that he recover against the said defendant the said sum of £2. 19. 11 & his costs by him in this behalf expended.

Absent Peter Butts Present Henry Taylor Esq.
Upon the petition of Peter Butts against Arthur Bradshaw for one pound six shillings & five pence due by note. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition & not appearing on the motion of the said plaintiff it is considered by the Court that he recover against the said defendant the said sum of £1. 6. 5 & interest from the 10th day of September 1766 till the time of payment & his costs by him in this behalf expended.
