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of the said defendant & he not now appearing to reply the effect.
Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff who proved
his account ^{to be} just recover against the said defendant the sum
of two pounds thirteen shillings & nine pence three farthings &
his costs by him in this behalf expended & it is ordered that
the sheriff sell as well the effects in the hands of Wm Cary Rose
who was formerly sworn on this attachment, as those herein
before mentioned & that he therewith discharge this judgment
& costs or so much thereof as the sale shall amount to first
paying the said Wm Cary Rose his demand of four pounds
six shillings & eleven pence one farthing & that he make
return of his proceedings thereon to the next Court

Clary Johnson having obtained an attachment against the
estate of Burwell Rose who hath privately removed himself
or so absconds that the ordinary process of law cannot be
served upon him for a debt due from the said Rose to the said
Johnson James Jent sheriff of this county now made
return that he had executed the said attachment on sundry
effects of the estate of the said defendant after satisfaction of a
debt due from the said Rose to Joshua Claus Jr. & he not now
appearing to reply the said effect it is considered by the court
that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant ten pounds
eighteen shillings & seven pence half penny, he having proved
his demand for that sum to be just & his costs by him in this
behalf expended & it is ordered that the sheriff discharge this
judgment if any money remains in his hands after
satisfaction of a judgment & costs obtained by Joshua
Claus Jr. against the said Burwell Rose and that he return
an account of his proceedings thereon to the next Court

Joshua Claus Jr. having obtained an attachment against the
estate of Burwell Rose who hath privately removed himself or so
absconds that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon
him for a debt due from the said Rose to the said Claus James
Jent sheriff of this county now made return that he
had executed the said attachment on six head of cattle three
of which the plaintiff agrees to release to one Samuel Pullen who
claims the same & the said defendant not now appearing to
reply the said effect it is considered by the court that the
plaintiff recover against him six pounds & his costs by him
in this behalf expended & it is ordered that the sheriff sell the
remaining three head of cattle at public auction for ready money
& therewith discharge this judgment & costs or so much thereof
as the sale shall amount to & that he pay the balance if
any remains after satisfaction of the judgment Johnson against
the said Burwell Rose & that he return an account of
his proceedings to the next Court
