"therein appointed have stated the profits arising from the moiety
"or half part of the testators real & personal estate together with
"the plaintiffs charges for maintaining & educating the defendant
"to wit that the sum of £139. 3. 6¹/₂ is due the said defendant
"We have also allotted one hundred acres of land adjoining the person
"including the plantation & houses or so much thereof as may contain
"the said quantity &... for the dower of the said Dolly on the lands
"whereof the testator died seized Given under our hands this 20th
"day of January 1771 Peter Butts Charles Coske Benja Ruffing
Whereupon it is decreed & ordered that this report be made the
judgment of this court which is done accordingly & that the
costs be equally born by the parties
