 effect of the judgment aforesaid Therefore it is considered by the court
 that the Plaintiffs take nothing by the writ aforesaid but for their
 false clamor be in mercy & the defendants go thereof hence
 without day & recover against the said Plaintiffs their costs by them
 about their defence in this behalf expended From which judgment
 the Plaintiffs prayes an appeal to the next day of the next
 General Court which is granted them giving security Whereupon

 Churchwardens of the parish of Nottoway bind out the said Barnes
 again according to Law

On the motion of Elizabeth Edwards who made oath according to Law
 Certificate was granted her to join in the probat of Wicajah Edwards
 will giving bond whenupon the said Elizabeth together with William
 Thomas & William her securities entered into and acknowledged
 their bond in the penalty of two thousand pounds for the said
 Elizabeths due & faithful performance of the last will & testament
 of the said Wicajah Edwards Decd

On the motion of John McLemore a witness for Groves Sharpe at the
 suit of Hamilton & Co it is ordered that the said Sharpe pay him fifty
 pounds of nut tobacco for two days attendance on this Court
