A report concerning a bridge over the Flat Swamp was this day returned in the words following. In Obedience to an Order of the Court of Southampton bearing date April 21th 1771 We have Viewed the bridge over the Flat Swamp near Cordall's Croft and find it built according to Agreement — Cordall Hoaght — John Blunt — Whereupon it is Ordered that the treasurer pay Nathaniel Bryant the undertaker Seven pounds nineteen shillings and six pence for the same

An Indenture of Settlement between Thomas Day Senr. of the one part and Thomas Day Jr. of the other part & a memorandum of livery of seisin & a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Thomas Day Senr. and ordered to be Recorded and Elizabeth the wife of the said Day Senr. personally appeared in Court and being first privately examined as the Law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the lands conveyed by the said Indenture

Thomas Thorpe came into Court and chose Joshua Nicholson for his guardian

Joshua Nicholson is by the court appointed guardian to Henry Thorpe and Phoebe Thorpe orphans of Aaron Thorpe came into court and chose Joshua Nicholson for their guardian Whereupon the said Joshua together with Benjamin Ruffin & John Barton Jr. gave securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand pounds for securing the said Orphans Estate & indemnifying the Court Paith Thorpe orphan of Aaron Thorpe chose John Thorpe for her guardian who with Joshua Nicholson & Henry Applewhite his securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds for securing the said orphans estate & indemnifying the Court

Ordered that Richard Pinks Arthur Vick & Abridgton Jones or any two of them do lett the repairs of the Three Cypress bridge & make report thereof to the Court
