 Annum) from the 12th day of April 1770 till paid & the other
 defendant Lawrence Joyner being arrested and not appearing On
 the motion of the plaintiff it is considered that judgment be
 entered against the said Defendant ^{Lawrence Joyner &} William Joyner who was
 returned security for his appearance unless he appear &
 plead at the next Court
