Upon the presentment of the grandjury against Elijah Pope for common swearing This day came the attorney for our lord the king And the said Elijah having been duly summoned & served with a copy of the said presentment and not appearing On the motion of the said attorney for our lord the king it is considered by the Court that the said Thomas forfeit and pay unto the churchwardens of the parish of St Luke twenty shillings according to the act of assembly in that case made and provided & that he also pay the cost of this presentment

Upon the presentment of the grandjury against Dewi Cooper for common swearing This day came the attorney for our
