

having been duly summons'd and served with a copy of the Petition and costs and not appearing on the motion of the said Plaintiff it is consider'd by the Court that he recover against the said Def^t the said sum of One pound twelve shillings and eleven pence half penny, and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

William Stannis who being sworn and examin'd inform'd the Court that on Sunday the 23^d June last Benjamin Newsum son of Joseph Thomas Jarrett Kirby Bittle & Henry Vaughan where then unlawfully gaming at the ordinary of Edmund Lay in this County Whereupon it is order'd by the Court the said Benjamin Newsum Thomas Jarrett Kirby Bittle & Henry Vaughan severally make their fines with our Sovereign Lord the King by the payment of five pounds each to the use of the parish of Saint Luke agreeable to an Act of Assembly in that case made and provided and that they severally pay costs and on hearing the said Edm^d Lay by his attorney the information against him for suffering unlawfull gaming in his house as an ordinary keeper is dismiss'd, And it is further order'd by the said Court that the said Thomas Jarrett & Kirby Bittle be taken into custody of the Sheriff until they give security for their good behaviour on the above conviction, Whereupon the said Benjamin Newsum with John Powell his security and Henry Vaughan with Simon Turner his security came into court and severally acknowledg'd themselves indebted to our Lord the King that is to say Benjamin Newsum and Henry Vaughan in the sum of Twenty pounds each and the said securitys Ten pounds each of their respective lands and tenements goods & chattels to our said Lord the King his heirs & successors render'd yet upon this condition that if the Benjamin Newsum and Henry Vaughan Jun^{rs} be of good behaviour towards our Sovereign Lord the King and all his liege subjects for the space of 12 Calendar Months from this time then this recognizance to be void.

Order'd that the Court be adj^d till the Court in course. James Redley
