

" In Obedience to an order of Court bearing date the 11th
day of October 1770 to us Peter Butts Benjamin Ruffen
and William Simmons directed to view and let the repair
of the Yssamusack bridge We did meet at the place aforesaid
said and did then and there let the repairs of the same
to William Simmons who undertook the same for the sum
of Nineteen pounds thirteen shillings and nine pence
(Error. see the Margin)

An Indenture of feoffment between John Seth and
Elizabeth his Wife of the one part and John Ray of
the other part was acknowledg'd by the said John &
Elizabeth, (she being first privately examin'd as the
Landreft) and ordred to be recorded.

A Deed of Gift from Henry Coker to Nathaniel Coker
was acknowledg'd by the said Henry Coker and ordred
to be recorded.

A Deed of Gift from Henry Coker to Jonathan Coker
was acknowledg'd by the said H.Y. Coker and ordred to
be recorded

A Deed of Gift from Henry Coker to Mary Coker was
acknowledg'd by the said Henr. Coker and ordred to be
recorded

Thomas Moore whabing surnam and examin'd inform'd
the Court that since the last Court John Adams Thomas
Garrett Ben Clifton have been guilty of unlawfull gaming
at his ordinary Whereupon it is ordred by the Court
that the said John Adams Ben Clifton and Thomas
Garrett severally make their fines with our Sovereign
Lord the King by the payment of Five pounds each to the use
of the parish of Notoway agreeable to an act of Assembly
in that case made and provided and that they severally
pay costs Whereupon John Adams with Benjamin
Ruffen Jun^r his Security ^{James Barnes son} Thos Garrett an infant Ben
Clifton with Tpsc Clifton his Security came into Court
and severally acknowledg'd themselves indebted to our Lord
the King that is to say John Adams James Barnes
for Thomas Garrett and Benjamin Clifton in the sum
of Twenty pounds each and the said Security's Son
pounds each of their respective lands & tenements good
and Chattels to our said Lord the King his heirs and Successors
renders render'd Yet upon this condition that of the
said John Adams Thos. Garrett and Benjamin Clifton
be of good behaviour towards our Sovereign Lord the King
