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of one year and that he be committed to the goal
till he find such security. Whereupon William
Simmons with James Moore his security came into
Court and severally acknowledg'd themselves
to our Lord the King that is to say the said
Simmons in the sum of Two Hundred and fifty p^{cs}
and the said James Moore in the sum of One
Hundred and twenty five pounds of their respec-
tive lands and tenements goods & chattels to our
Lord the King his heirs and successors. And
Upon this condition that if the said William
Simmons be of good behaviour towards our Sov-
erign Lord the King and all his Majesty's liege
subjects for the space of 12 Calendar months then
this recognizance to be void.

The Sheriff being order'd to summon Samuel Clifton
to aid and assist in bringing the aforesaid William
Simmons before this Court for his disorderly be-
haviour together with Joshua Claud the said
Claud complain'd of being ill treated and challenge
by the said Clifton and that he refus'd the legal
summons of the Sheriff. The said Clifton appear-
ing and being heard and making proper concessions
to the Court is discharge'd.

On the motion of Thomas Oretlow, George Sum-
merell, Newsum Branch Benjamin Swinburn Jesse
Wombwell Witnesses for William Stephenson against
Simon Stephenson Geo^r of Thomas Stephenson it is
order'd that the said William pay them respectively
that is Tho^s Oretlow seven by five pounds of Tob^o
for three days attendance, George Summerell one
Hundred and as of Tobacco for four days attendance
Newsum Branch seventy five pounds Tobacco for
three days attendance Benjamin Swinburn seventy
five pounds Tobacco for three days attendance
on this Court and Jesse Wombwell One Hundred
pounds of Tobacco for four days attendance on
this Court according to Law.

On the motion of Edmund Leay, Edward
Mial and Thomas Robinson Witnesses for
James Rayley against Jacob Simmons it is order'd
that the said James Rayley paid to the Edmund
Leay One Hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco
for five days attendance on this Court to Andrew
Mial One Hundred pounds of Tobacco for four days
attendance on this Court and Thom^s Robinson
