Whereupon the said Moses with Joshua Wood
his security enter'd into and acknowledg'd their
Bond in the penalty of One thousand Pounds for
securing the said orphans estate and indemnifying
the Court

Isam Davis is by the Court appointed Guardian
to Henry Davis infant orphan of Henry Davis
dec'd Whereupon the said Isam with Randol.
Davis and Anthony Evans his securitys enter'd
into and acknowledg'd their Bond in the penalty
of Two hundred and fifty pounds for securing the
said orphans estate and indemnifying the Court

Order'd that the Church Wardens of the parish
of Storroway bind out Henry Davis infant orphan
of Henry Davis according to Law

Absent Henry Saylor present Edwin Gray
a Commission from his Excellency the Governor for
James Say Ridley to the Sheriff of this County and
pleasure was produced in court by the said James
Say Ridley and read and thereupon he together
with Henry Saylor Daniel Fishers his securitys
