

entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the sum of One thousand pounds payable and condition is as the said condition is directed and then the said Ridley having first taken the oaths appointed by act of parliament to be taken instead of the oaths of allegiance and Supremacy and taken and subscribed the abjuration oath and subscribed the test was sworn Sheriff of this County.

William Skines Thomas Ridley James Jones John Simmon and Arthur Gaster to the usual oaths to his majesty person and government and subscribed the abjuration oath and test and on the motion of James Whitley Gentleman Sheriff of this County were sworn his under sheriffs.

An Indenture of feoffment between John Pope of the one part and James Jordan Scott and William Williams of the other part was on the 12th December 1741 proved by the oaths of John Beale and by the solemn affirmation Jordan Denson two of the witnesses thereto and on the 9th January 1742 was further proved by the solemn affirmation of Tho. Draper another of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

An Indenture of feoffment between William Bosman and Elizabeth his Wife of the one part & William Scaggin of the other part with the Memorandum of livery and seizen and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the within William Bosman and Elizabeth his Wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.
