iance and supremacy and taken and subscrib'd the  
abjuration oath and subscrib'd the test, was sworn  
Sheriff of this County.

William Stines Thomas Ridley James Jones John Simm  
and Arthur Foster to the usual oaths to his majesty  
person and government and subscrib'd the abjuration  
oath and test and on the nations of James Ridley  
gentleman sheriff of this county were sworn his un-  
der sheriff.

An Indenture of feoffment between John Pope of  
the one part and James Jordan Scott and William  
Williams of the other part was on the 12th December  
1771 proved by the oaths of John Beale and by the  
solemn affirmation Jordan Lenson two of the wit-  
nesses thereto and on the 9<sup>th</sup> January 1772 was  
further proved by the solemn affirmation of Thos  
Graper another of the witnesses thereto and ord-  
ered to be recorded.

An Indenture of feoffment between William  
Bosman and Elizabeth his wife of the one part &  
William Scoggin of the other part with the Mem-  
orandum of livery and Seizure and the receipt  
thereon endos'd were acknowledg'd by the witness  
William Bosman and Elizabeth his wife she being  
first privately examined as the law directs and  
sworn to be recorded.
