Barnes, John Johnson, John Garner, Jethro Benson, Dimpsey Johnson, Jonathan Bowen Burnell Rawlings Robert Adams James Booth William Urquhart Benjamin Waller John Cobb who being elected tryed and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue join'd do say that the defendant hath not comply'd with the conditions in the writing obligatory mention'd as the plaintiff against him hath complain'd and they do assess the damages by occasion to be Six pounds one shillings and two pence besides his costs Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant his damages aforesaid assess and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c.

On the Motion of James Moore and Elizabeth Moore Witnesses for Samuel Clifton at the suit of John Meacom it is order'd that the said Samuel pay the said James Moore twenty five pence tobacco for one days attendance and Elizabeth Moore for two days attendance on this Court fifty pence tobacco accord^g to law
Order'd that the Court be adjur'd till the Court in course.
