It is the opinion of this Court that the said Adam Fleming hath not been guilty of any trespass on the estate of the said Clifton by the Sale of the said Mare to the said Taylor and thereupon the said complaint is or order'd to be dismiss'd as groundless.

An Account Current of the estate of Thomas Stephenson was reported Pursuant to the order of this Court and order'd to be recorded.

The last will of Ann Edmunds was this day presented in Court by Mary Edmunds the Executor therein named and proved by the oaths of Mary Edmunds and Shos Edmunds two of the Witnesses thereto and order'd to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Exor's who made oath according to Law certificate was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Executor with Thomas Edmunds his security enter'd into & acknowledg'd their Bond in the penalty of One Thousand and Pound for the said Mary Edmunds due and faithfull administration of the estate of the said Deceaseds performance of her will.

On the motion of Job Wrights who made oath according to Law certificate his granted him for obtaining Letters of Administration on the est. of Richard Wootton giving security whereupon the said Job with Benj^m Simons his security enter'd into and acknowledg'd Their Bond in the penalty of Two Thousand pounds for the said Job Wrights due administration of the said decedents estate.
