two of the witnesses thereto and on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 1772  
the same was further proved by the oaths of John  
Elzey another of the witnesses thereto and order'd  
to be recorded.

An Indenture of feoffment between Charles Barham  
of the one part and James Barham of the other part  
with a receipt thereon endos'd were acknowledg'd  
by the parties and order'd to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between David Bunn  
and patience his wife of the one part and Schut  
ting Council of the other part with a receipt there-  
on endos'd were acknowledg'd by the said David  
Bun and patience his wife she being first privat  
ly examin'd as the law directs and order'd to be  
recorded.

Order'd that James Gray John Bailey and  
Barnaby Bailey or any two of them do examine  
state and settle an Acco<sup>ts</sup> Current of Henry Starks  
estate and make report thereof to the next Court

Order'd that James Gray John Bailey and Barnaby  
Bailey or any two of them do examine state  
settle an Acco<sup>ts</sup> Current of Elizabeth Starks estate  
and make report thereof to the next Court

An Inventory of the estate of Nathan Pope was  
this day return'd and order'd to be recorded

Order'd that William Thomas Henry Briggs  
John Blom or any two of them do examine state  
and settle an acco<sup>ts</sup> Cur<sup>ts</sup> of Joshua Vicks estate  
and make report thereof to the next Court

On the petition of Jesse Watkins ag<sup>st</sup> John  
Byrd Junior for two pounds 12/4. this day came
