

Jones two of the Executors thereto named made & sworn by the oaths of Thomas Janell John Cooper Winnipeg Cooper three of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the aforesaid Exors who made oath according to law liberty being reserved for the other exor John Simmonds to join herein certificate was granted the said exor for obtaining a probat hereof giving security Whereupon John Simmonds Sen^r John Simmonds junior and James Moore his securities came into court and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of five hundred Pds for the said Johns due and faithfull administration of the estate of the said James Jones and the performance of his will.

The last will and testament of Thomas Moore was presented in court sworn to by Edmund Gay one of the witnesses thereto who deposed that he saw Thomas Storrs now deceased another witness subscribe his name as such in the presence of the testator and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of Sarah Moore James Moore and Richard Blow whos made oath certificate was granted for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Thomas with the said will annexed giving security whereupon Sarah Moore with James Moore Richard Blow James Jones Henry Appleton etc her security entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of five thousand pounds for the said Sarah due and faithfull administration of the estate of the said Thomas Moore and performance of the will.

Ordered that Joshua Richardson, Hardy Harris Owen Myrick and Robert Jones or any three do appraise of them being first sworn before a Justice of peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estates of Thomas Moore deceased and return the appraisement to court.

An Indenture of feoffment between Richard Bellamy Blow of the one part and Arthur Pick of the other part with a receipt thereon made were acknowledged by the said Blow and Mary his wife she being first privata by examination as the law directs and ordered to be record ed.

An Indenture of feoffment between Edward Lundy of the one part and to Derry Lundy with a receipt thereon made were proved by the oaths of Henry Scott and James Scott two of the witnesses thereto and
