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Richard Kella his security entered into court and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds for the said Benjamin due and faithful administration of the estate of the said Martha and the performance of her will.

Ordered that Benjamin Griffen Moses Phillips and Robert Shieles and John Pond or any Three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any & personal estate of Martha Branch and return the appraisement to court.

James Basden and Joseph Powell having refused to have the lines of the land to be proceSSION'd which is certified by John Boykin and Simon Boykin the freeholders appointed Ordered that the surveyor with a jury lay out and proceSSION the same according to law.

Thomas Chapple and Richard Pond freeholders appointed to proceSSION, certified a disputed line between the lands of John Meacon & the estate of Thomas Callen deceased but it appearing that the parties have agreed to settle the said lines the said certificate is dismissed.
