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pay the aforesaid sum of 100 dollars into the hands of the Sheriff when due & that he therewith discharge this judgement and costs and return an account of his proceedings herein to the next court

Daniel Fisher plaintiff having obtained an attachment against the estate of John Spence who hath privately removed himself or so absconds that the ordinary process of Law cannot be served upon him James Day Ridly this day made return that he had executed the said attachment on all the estate of the said John in the hands of John Thorpe his Garnishee Whereupon this day came the said Henry Taylor by his attorney and the said Garnishee having been duly summoned appeared and upon oath declared that 100 dollars are bequeathed to the s.^d Spence by the said John Thorpe acc'd payable the 10th day of August next when he is willing and ready to pay the same Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of £2. 10 (after first having discharged an attachment Henry Taylor obtained ag^t the said Spence for £5. 7. 6. 109 to wit: £15^s. & costs also an attachment obtained by Ric^d. Kella ag^t the s.^d Spence for £1. 9) and that the s.^d Garnishee pay the aforesaid sum of 100 dollars into the hands of the Sheriff when due & that he therewith discharge this judgement and costs and return the account of his proceedings herein to the next court.

John Simmons is by the Court appointed Guardian appointed Guardian of Mary Jones orphan of James Jones deceased whereupon the said John with Robert Jones and James Jones his security entered into & acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of two thousand pounds for securing the said Orphan's estate and indemnifying the Court.

Jordan Benson administrator of Joseph Benson having obtained an attachment against Benjamin Benson the motion of the plaintiffs to take the deposition of Anthony Warwick who is about to depart this Colony is overruled by the Court the pl^{ts} refusing to agree to give the def.^s notice of execution the said Court & cont.^s
