ther proved by the oath of Peter Stay another of the
witnesses thereto and oradie to be recorded with
the power of attorney thereto annexed and to
be recorded.

An Indenture of feoffment between John Nall Cath
arine his wife and Mary Storr of the one part and
Candice Gay of the other part, was proved by the oath
of William Stay and by the solemn affirmation of Ben
Bailey two of the witnesses thereto and on the 1st July
1772 was further proved by the oaths of Peter Stay
another of the witnesses thereto and with a copy
of the power of attorney thereto annexed and to
be recorded.

Ordered that the prison of this County be well
pared and that Thomas Bunting Richard Reeks
and John Blom or any two agree with persons
to perform the same.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned to the
Court in course. *Abd^l Jones*
