An Indenture of feoffment between John Hall and Catharine his wife of the one part and a Rich<sup>d</sup> Blom of the other part was proved by the oath of William Stay and by the solemn affirmations of Benj<sup>m</sup> Bailey two of the witnesses thereto and on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1772 this Indenture was further proved by the oath of Peter Stay another of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded with the power of attorney thereto annexed

An Indenture of feoffment between John Hall Catharine his wife and Mary Storr of the one part and Edmund Gay of the other parts was proved by the oath of William Stay and by the solemn affirmations of Benj<sup>m</sup> Bailey two of the witnesses thereto and on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 1772 was further proved by the oaths of Peter Stay another of the witnesses thereto and with a copy of the power of attorney thereto annexed ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the prison of this County be well turned and that Thomas Blunt Richard Richs and John Blom or any two agree with persons to perform the same

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in course
