Ordered that the Churchwardens of the parish of Stowaway bind out David Long orphan of Arthur Long according to law.

Ordered that the Churchwardens of Saint Lukes bind out John Smith child of Susannah Smith according to law.

Upon the petition of Thomas Hancock against Moses Johnson for four pounds due by acc't this day came the parties by their attorneys who being full heard it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said four pounds and his costs by him in his suit in this behalf expended.

Upon the petition of John Ruffin junior against Andrew Harrison for five pounds for dealing with a negro belonging to said Ruffin this day came the parties and by their attorneys who being full heard it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said five pounds.
