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Wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and orders to be recorded.

Upon the petition of James Dunlop adm^r of Tho^s Fisher against Britain Stale for Two pounds eighteen shillings and nine pence half penny due by acct^t the said defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and account was called and not appearing and the petitioner having proved his account by his oath It is considered by the court that the said plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of One pound fourteen shillings and 9¹/₂ and his costs by him in his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c.

Upon the petition of John Verrill against Art. Ridley for Two pounds four shillings due by note This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and defendant being summoned and served with a copy of the petition and summons and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of One pound four shillings and six pence with interest from the 25th Dec^r 1764 till paid and his costs by him in his suit in this behalf expended and the s^d defendant in mercy &c.

Moses Foster guardian of Elias Westbrook this day returned an acct^t of his guardianship of the said orphan's estate upon oath which being approved by the court was ordered to be recorded.
