On the motion of William Barrett and John John son W^t witness for Shaareck Johnson against Richard Kirby Craud that the said Shaareck pay the said William Twenty three pounds of Tobacco for one days attendance on this court and travelling sixteen miles and the said John Eighty eight pds of Tobacco for one days attendance on this court and travelling twenty one days according to law.
